Family camp fees are for everyone staying the complete week from registration on Sunday at 3:00 PM, until Friday evening. Any and all other times will be charged the Per Diem rate. Registrations are accepted on a space-available basis. Every individual must be registered to be on site during a family camp. Per Diem and day use visitor fees cover applicable services such as lodging, meals, programs, access to facilities, and liability insurance.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$80.00 will be required to save your space. On-line registration is preferred, but there is a camp registration downloadable form that can be printed from the website.

All camps run Sunday afternoon to Friday evening.

All camps include age appropriate Bible studies, various types of worship, camp store, and good meals.

#### **Directions to Camp Lambec**

From Pittsburgh & the South: Take I-79 North to Exit 178 onto I-90 West on the south side of Erie. Stay on I-90 West for 15 miles to Exit 6 and turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow the directions "From I-90" below. \*\*\*

From the East: Take I-90 West to Exit 6; turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow "From I-90" below. From Cleveland and the West: Take I-90 East, enter into PA. Stay on I-90 East to Exit 6, turn right at the end of the ramp. Follow "From I-90" below. \*\*\*

\*\*\*From I-90. Go North on PA 215 for about 4 miles, cross US 20, cross PA 5 (PA 215 ends at PA 5). Go .2 mile; bear left at Peggy Gray's Candy Store. Go 1.5 miles on Old Lake Road to the

Lambec entrance on the right. Look for white fence & red barn.

A non-refundable \$80 deposit is required for youth or family camps.

Payment can be made by credit card by paying the deposit only, setting up a payment plan, or paying the total amount.

Fees are due on or before the opening day of the selected camp.

Check in time starts at 3:00 PM on Sunday. All camp programs finish Friday evening.
